WATER TOWER MAINTENANCE Residents Advised to Have Stored Water at Hand

Residents and Water Utility Customers of the Town of Pictou are advised starting June 9th the water tower will be taken out of service for sandblasting, repainting and repairs. This maintenance is expected to take up to 28 days. It is expected that residents will notice little to no difference under normal circumstances however could experience low pressure or water loss in the event of a break. Customers are asked to have water on hand for emergencies such as these. During this time a water conservation order will be in effect. Customers will be advised on the time period an order is in effect through a banner at the corner of Alfred Street and West River Road.

Residents and Businesses may experience discoloured water and very low pressure. It is strongly recommended to have stored water on hand before June 9 until the end of the month.

The Town will use a temporary storage bladder to act as a reservoir; however, it will not have the capacity of the water tower. In the event of a water break or periods of high water use, i.e. breakfast and dinner time, it will drain quickly. Therefore everyone is being asked to conserve water.
