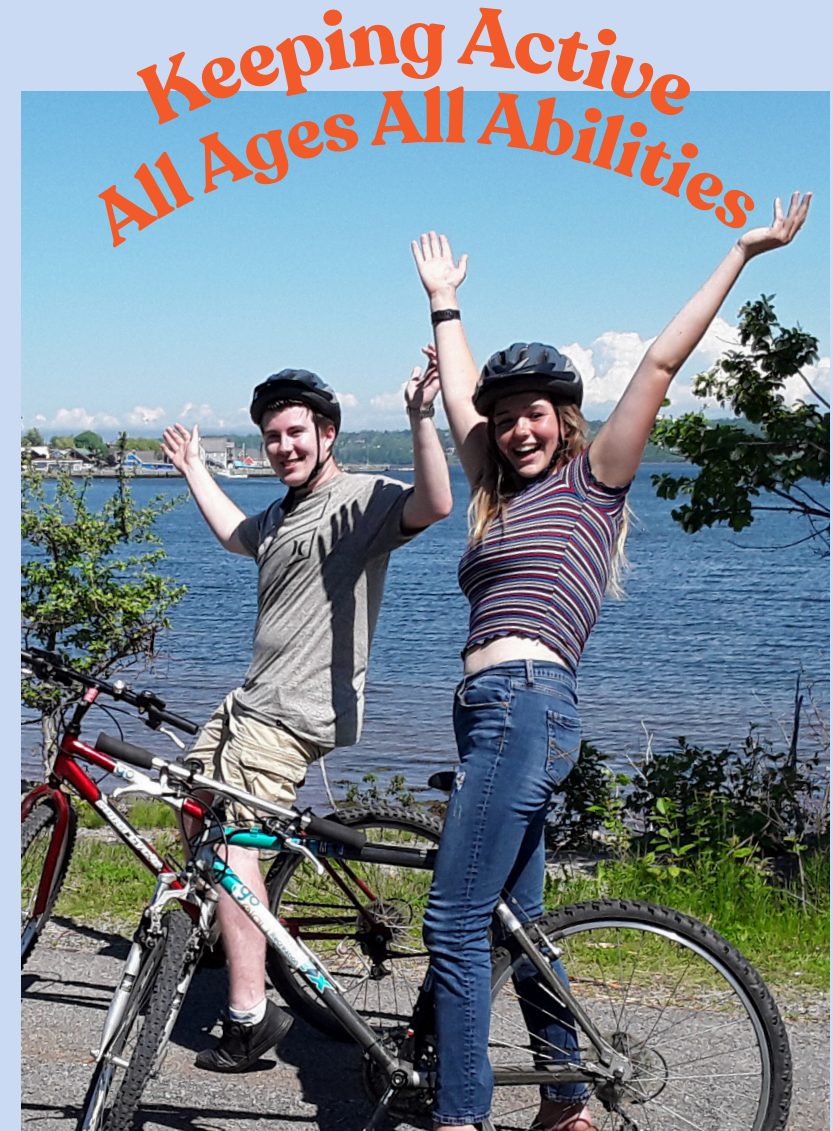

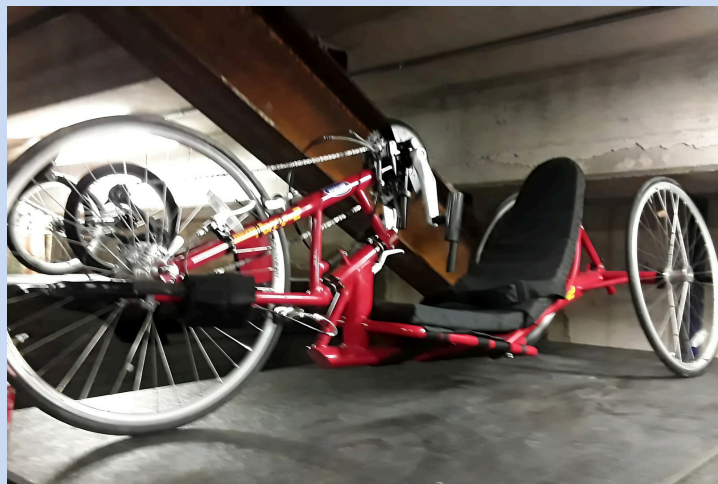

Tennis and Pickleball memberships are available at the Town Office. Rackets can be found beside the building of the court.



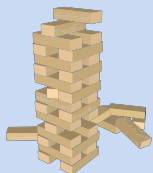
Basketball

Public Skating

Between November to March there are FREE public skates in the various arenas throughout Pictou County. Check for a full schedule of skate times in Pictou on Town website.

The Pictou Fisheries Training Pool offers drop-in rates as low as \$11 and \$33 for a family rate.



Indoor walking

At the Hector Arena, October to March. Walk the indoor track around the ice surface; by donation.
